COMMUNITY GARDENING AGREEMENT

Plots need to be weed and debris free year round

Your Responsibilities as a Community Gardener

1. Payment of Membership and Garden Plot fees – Plot fee is \$25 per plot. Gardeners are responsible for maintaining their plots, walkways and adjacent fence lines surrounding their plot clear and free of weeds and for other assigned areas of the garden that require regular maintenance. Gardeners shall at no time till, plant, harvest or weed another gardener’s plot, except as agreed to on garden workdays or by prior agreement with the plot holder. Watering of the gardening plots is the responsibility of individual gardeners. Be sure that water is completely turned off before leaving the garden.
2. Participation in Community Garden Activities – Henry County Community Garden Inc. will schedule garden workdays for the purpose of overall maintenance of the garden (i.e. weeding, tilling, planting, and fertilizing)
3. Individual plots are for the benefit of specific gardeners and should not be picked by others. Plots cannot be given away by you to anyone else and vegetables must not be sold.
4. Proper use, care and storage of tools and equipment is required.
 - a. Hand tools and power equipment shall be properly cleaned after use and returned to the garden shed for storing
5. Adhere to specific security and safety measures.
 - a. Walkways must be clear of obstacles and debris—hoses to be returned to storage area following use.
 - b. Use of unapproved chemicals in the garden is strictly prohibited. ONLY Organic pesticides are allowed and will be provided by Henry County Community Garden Inc.
 - c. Other safety measures as required and notice
6. Water, hand tools, hoses, tillers and other gardening supplies are provided. Seeds for planting both winter and summer garden are provided by the community garden. Transplants, if desired, to be provided by gardener.
7. If a plot is not harvested while the food is ripe the plot owner must relinquish rights to the produce and the produce will be taken to food bank

I. Release, Hold Harmless and Agreement Not to Sue

I (We) fully understand that my participation in the Community Garden exposes me to the risk of personal injury death or property damage. I hereby acknowledge that I am voluntarily participating in this activity and agree to assume any such risks to myself or any family member participating with me. Further, in consideration for being granted permission to participate as a gardener at the below named community garden, I hereby agree for myself and for personal representatives, heirs and next of kin to: Forever release, discharge, and agree not to sue Henry County Community Garden Inc, its representatives, employees and volunteers for any injury, death or damage to or loss of personal property arising out of, or in connection with my family’s participation in the activity from whatever cause, including the active or passive negligence of CGHC or any other participants in this activity
